Flow-MER is a program run by the [Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder](#) (CEWH) to undertake monitoring, evaluation and research (MER) on the outcomes of environmental water delivery to provide information to support environmental water management in the Murray-Darling Basin.

The CEWH is committed to partnering and working meaningfully with Aboriginal People in the planning, delivery and monitoring of water for the environment. This includes providing opportunities to empower and support Aboriginal People to care for Country and building partnerships with Aboriginal People in ways that they determine. The program has been running for several years with three new MER areas added to the program in 2024 including the Lower Balonne River region.
