Internship, Placement and Exchange Opportunities

85 days of Professional Experience in schools of which 20 days represent an internship

Compulsory Training Component

Compulsory 85 days of work integrated learning in primary school settings, delivered across one Discipline course (EDST1120 Foundations of Literacy) and three professional experience courses (EDST2002, EDST6760 and EDST6765).

- EDST6765 (12 UOC) Professional Experience 2 / Internship cannot be studied concurrently with another course
