1. Breach of the Student Code and Student Misconduct

- 1.1 A breach of the Student Code means a failure by a student to meet one or more of the responsibilities found in the Student Code. It may refer to a single breach or multiple breaches.
- 1.2 UNSW regards any breach of the Student Code as unacceptable and will manage complaints or reports of a breach of the Student Code according to this Procedure.
- 1.3 Depending upon the circumstances, allegations of plagiarism will usually be handled according to the UNSW or . This Procedure applies when 'serious plagiarism' or repeated instances of student plagiarism have been identified.
- 1.4 Figure 1 below illustrates the spectrum along which breaches occur from a minor breach to a serious breach of the Student Code.
