How should you plan your workload?

UNSW delivers courses in three trimesters across a calendar year. This offers you flexibility with your annual enrolment (48UOC) as one term can have fewer number of UOC.

If you are an international student, or new to studying law, you should consider reducing your workload in your first term to 12UOC instead of 18UOC. This will require you to enrol in 18UOC the next two <https://nucleus.unsw.edu.au/>

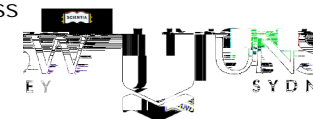

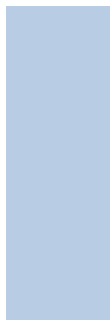
