



A Guide for Outbound Exchange Students

If you cannot find a UNSW course that is suitable for a transfer of credit, you may still be approved for a course in your home country.

4 Request course approvals via [Endeavour](#).

supporting documentation with course outlines, class contact hours, and so on.

5 In five business days, you will receive an email notifying you of the outcome of your course approval application. Where a course has been declined, you will be able to see why. If the reason is insufficient information, you will have an opportunity to send the application again with additional details.

6 Once you have a sufficient number of courses approved, you will be able to print your approved Transfer of Credit (TOC) form. If you are a student in any of the following programs, you can submit the form to the School of Psychology via the ["Ask a Question"](#) link at the bottom of the "UNSW Student Portal Web Form" page.

- Psychology (6 hours)
- Psychological Science;
- Psychology (6 hours) Law; or
- Psychological Science Law.

Students in Psychology (6 hours) Law and Psychological Science Law require a signature from the Faculty of Law as well.

Otherwise, you should visit your respective Program Authorities.
