The verb mo ' - (*there is/are*; *exist*) can be used as an auxiliary verb in Korean to express that someone or something is in some state. In particular, with the overbyou can express that:

- (1) someone or something is in the state of doing something (that is expressed by the main verb), and
- (2) someone or something is in a state that is the result of an action performed (that is expressed by the main verb).

We have already learnt how the pattern V to expresses (1) (see Unit 19). Here are some examples.

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Not all the verbs can be used in the VST slot in this pattern. Only the intransitive verbs, which do not require a grammatical object, ie, a noun marked 340% , and only the verbs that imply, by virtue of their dictionary meaning, a clearly identi able result.

For instante; - (to sleep) cannot be used in this pattern because when one sleeps one simply sleeps, Se; - signi es a process which does not involve any clearly identi able result. By contrast,
